and tell **scribe** the stars,
if thou be able to *number* **scribe** them:
and he said unto him,
So **Thus** shall thy seed be.
6 And he *believed* **trusted** in the **LORD Yah Veh**;
and he *counted* **fabricated** it to him
for *righteousness* **justness**.
7 And he said unto him, *I am the LORD I* — **Yah Veh**
that brought thee out of Ur of the *Chaldees* **Kesediym**,
to give thee this land to *inherit* **possess** it.
8 And he said, *Lord GOD Adonay Yah Veh*,
whereby shall I know that I shall *inherit* **possess** it?
9 And he said unto him,
Take me an heifer of three *years old*,
and a she goat of three *years old*,
and a ram of three *years old*,
and a turtledove, and a *young pigeon* **youngling**.
10 And he took unto him all these,
and *divided* **sectioned** them in the midst,
and *laid each piece* **gave the sections**
one against another **man meeting friend**:
but the birds *divided* **sectioned** he not.
11 And when the *fowls* **swoopers**
came down **descended** upon the carcasses,
Abram drove them away.
12 And when the sun was going down,
a *deep sound* sleep fell upon Abram; and, *lo* **behold**,
an *horror a terror* of great darkness fell upon him.
13 And he said unto Abram,
Know of a surety **In knowing, know**
that thy seed shall be a *stranger* **sojourner**
in a land that is not their's,
and shall serve them;
and they shall *afflict* **humble** them four hundred years;
14 And also that *nation* **goyim**, whom they shall serve,
will I judge **shall I plead their cause**:
and *afterward* **thus** shall they come out
with great *substance* **acquisitions**.
15 And thou shalt go to thy fathers in *peace* **shalom**;
thou shalt be *buried* **entombed**
in a *good old age* **grayness**.
16 But in the fourth generation
they shall *come* **return** hither *again*:
for the *iniquity* **perversity** of the *Amorites* **Emoriy**
is not yet *full* **at shalom**.
17 And **so be** it *came to pass*,
that, when the sun went down, and it was *dark* **dusk**,
behold a smoking furnace,
and a *burning lamp* **flambeau of fire**
that passed between those pieces.
18 In *the same* **that** day
the LORD made **Yah Veh cut** a covenant with Abram,
saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land,
from the river of *Egypt* **Misrayim** unto the great river,
the river Euphrates:
19 The *Kenites* **Qeyniy**, and the *Kenizzites* **Qenaziy**,
and the *Kadmonites* **Qadmoniy**,
20 And the *Hittites* **Hethiy**,
and the *Perizzites* **Perizziy**, and the *Rephaims* **Rephaim**,
21 And the *Amorites* **Emoriy**, and the *Canaanites* **Kenaaniy**,

Now *Sarai* **Saray** Abram's *wife* **woman**
bare **birthed** him no children:
and she had an *handmaid* **a maid**,
an Egyptian **a Misrayim**, whose name was Hagar.
2 And *Sarai* **Saray** said unto Abram,
Behold *now* **I beseech**,
the LORD **Yah Veh** hath restrained me from *bearing* **birthing**:
I *pray* **beseech** thee, go in unto my maid;
it may be that **perhaps**
I may *obtain children* **be builded** by her.
And Abram hearkened to the voice of *Sarai* **Saray**.
3 And *Sarai* **Saray** Abram's *wife* **woman**
took Hagar her maid the *Egyptian* **Misrayim**,
after Abram had dwelt ten years
at the end of ten years that Abram had settled
in the land of *Canaan* **Kenaan**,

but the birds he sections not.
11 And when the swoopers descend on the carcasses,
Abram drives them away.
12 And the sun goes down
and a sound sleep falls on Abram;
and behold, a terror of great darkness befalls him:
and he says to Abram,
13 In knowing, know that your seed
is a sojourner in a land not theirs:
and they serve them;
and they humble them four hundred years:
14 and also that goyim whom they serve
— I plead their cause:
and thus they come out with great acquisitions.
15 And you go to your fathers in shalom;
— entombed in good grayness:
16 and in the fourth generation they return here:
for the perversity of the Emoriy is not yet at shalom.
17 And so be it,
when the sun sets and it is dusk,
behold, a smoking furnace and a flambeau of fire
passes between those pieces.
18 In that day Yah Veh cuts a covenant with Abram,
saying, To your seed I gave this land
— from the river of Misrayim
to the great river — the river Euphrates:
19 the Qeyniy and the Qenaziy and the Qadmoniy

Now Saray the woman of Abram births not to him;
