In order to straight–cut what Scripture teaches, it is necessary to know what Scripture says.

### Welcome, Dear Friend,

To the *exeGeses parallel BIBLE* — a blessed new experience in Scripture understanding.

In the year 1975, when I entrusted my whole being to Adonay, He instructed me to give up my profession and to hearken to His leading.

Adonay then led me directly to His Word, the Scripture. Even though I had thought of myself as a theologian, I was soon aware of how much I did not know.

Adonay brought this to my attention when I began to diligently search the Scripture to understand the literal meanings of **spirit** and **soul**, and their distinguishing differences. I soon discovered that most versions translated **nephesh**, the Hebrew word for **soul**, into more than forty different words. Then I discovered that **pneuma**, the Hellenic word for **spirit** was consistently translated **spirit** or **ghost** with one glaring exception; and that one exception, *John* **Yahn** 3:8, is a serious mistranslation.

Now those are just two words. What would I discover if I researched every Hebrew, Aramaic, and Hellenic word of Scripture — more than 14,000 words? And how would I be able to share this knowledge with the world?

Why not take the most revered Version, and insert these exegeses right within the Scripture passage?

That was it! — the Authorized King James Version with its inspiration, and the exegeses with their expositions. And thus began the most blessed ten years of my life; and the First Edition, The Authorized King James Version of 1611 in exeGeses was birthed.

And in less than one year, Bible Colleges are using it as a text; Messianic Congregations are using it to witness of the Messiah; and the First Edition was exhausted.

And after another year of proofing and editing, the *exeGeses* ready research *BIBLE*, also based on the Authorized King James Version was introduced.

But there was yet no literal translation and transliteration of the Scripture in the language of today. And so the *exeGeses* companion *BIBLE* was birthed.

And with the advent of computers, even I in my prime of life, was able to "cut and paste " a few thousand pages from the exeGeses ready research BIBLE and the exeGeses companion BIBLE and produce this exeGeses parallel BIBLE.

So this is our purpose — that you hold in your hand, and read the Authorized King James Version exactly as first published — and at the very same moment, and without any further research, have the *exegeses* at your fingertips.

Let's take a step by step journey so that you may better see for yourself all that the *exeGeses* affords you – how the *exeGeses* will enrich your spiritual life, enlighten your spiritual understanding, and deepen your knowledge of Scripture.

**SCRIPTURE** is the word of Elohim inscribed to humanity. Scripture (singular) consists of 66 volumes of Scriptures (plural).

The Old Covenant was originally inscribed on scrolls in Hebraic, and Aramaic (also known as Chaldean). The New Covenant was inscribed on scrolls in Hebraic, Aramaic, and Hellenic (also known as Bible Greek).

### MANUSCRIPT DISTINCTIONS

All the oldest manuscript copies of both covenants consisted exclusively of **CAPITAL LETTERS** with no **lower case letters.** The Old Covenant manuscripts consisted of consonants only. Vowels were added by a points system in the Masoretic text between the second and fifteenth centuries Anno Domini.

The exeGeses ready research BIBLE in the left column follows the tenses of the Authorized King James Version.

However, the Old Covenant was written primarily in the present active tenses. The *exeGeses* companion *BIBLE* in the right column retains this present active tense, and brings to life a new experience of personal involvement in the reading.

Whereas the SEPTUAGINT VERSION Hellenized the Old Covenant, the *exeGeses companion BIBLE* Hebraises the awe and majesty that was originally in the New Covenant before it was Hellenized.

The language of our Adonay Yah Shua Messiah was Aramaic and Hebrew. And so all his Old Covenant quotations must be accurately translated from the Hebrew. Whenever Yah Veh spoke to the Apostle Paulos, it was in the Hebrew language. Most often, when Adonay Yah Shua Messiah did a sign, his recorded language was in Hebrew or Aramaic. Even some of his final words on the stake are recorded in Hebrew.

### **DEFINITIONS:**

**exegeses** *plural noun* — the expository critiques of Scripture.

**ready** *adjective* — expert; fitted for immediate use; prepared.

**research** adjective — pertaining to exhaustive investigation; studious inquiry.

**companion** *noun* — literally, to co—bread, as in communion; that which co—partakes.

**parallel** *noun* — lying evenly, side by side: thus this *exeGeses parallel BIBLE* presents the *exeGeses ready research BIBLE* and the *exeGeses companion BIBLE* side by side.

**BIBLE** noun — Book; when capitalized, refers to the Scripture.

**literal** *adjective* — according to the letter; precise, exact.

All of the exegeses have been thoroughly researched and then translated and/or transliterated as literally as possible.

**translation** *noun* — the rendering of a **word** from one language to another.

Through the years some words have taken on different meanings. In 1611, **charity** meant **love**; whereas today it means **alms**. Read 1 Corinthians 13:1. Also, many different manuscriptal words have been translated to the same English word. For example: Where the Authorized Version does not distinguish between the Hellenic verbs **agapao** (love) and **phileo** (befriend), the *exeGeses* does. Read *John* **Yahn** 21:15–17.

**transliteration** *noun* — the rendering of an **alphabet** from one language to another.

Hundreds of words, which in most Versions have been **translated**, are now **transliterated** in the **execuses**. To mention just a few – **amen**, **apostolize**, **charism**, **charisma**, **Diabolos**, **eucharist**, **Gay Hinnom**, **goyim**, **hades**, **Halalu Yah**, **hanukkah**, **hubris**, **menorah**, **metamorphose**, **parousia**, **shabbath**, **shalom**, **sheol**, **tartarus**, **torah** – all these and more are clearly exposited in the LEXICON.

### TRANSLITERATION of NAMES:

TRANSLITERATION is of even more importance when dealing with names because of their rich meanings.

Elohim the Father first revealed his **name** to Mosheh as **HYH** – the eternal I AM. Elohim the Son also revealed himself as the eternal I AM. Read Exodus 3:13,14, *John* **Yahn** 4:26, 8:58.

The inscribers revealed his **name** as **YHVH** – sequentually as early as Genesis 2:4, and chronologically as early as *Job* **lyob** 1:6.

The *exeGeses* presents his **name** vowel pointed as **Yah Veh**.

Most Versions often render the **name Yah Veh** incorrectly with the **title LORD** – all capital letters. This is a caving in to the traditions of certain Hebrews who said his **name** was too holy to pronounce. It is more likely that the ancient Hebrews feared the extreme consequences of dishonoring the **name Yah Veh**. For the Hebrews used the **name Yah Veh** to covenant, and whenever the covenant was broken, serious consequences followed. Read Leviticus 19:12. However, they do transliterate his **name** in very few verses. See Exodus 6:3, Psalm 83:18, *Isaiah* **Yesha Yah** 12:2, 28:4; also see Genesis 22:14, Exodus 17:15, Judges 6:24, Psalm 23:1 for **compound names**.

In most Versions, the **name Yah Veh** is also mistranslated with the **title** *Lord* throughout the New Covenant. One reason is because the Hellene has no equivalent word for **Yah Veh** – and uses *Kurios* throughout.

However there is a clue in the Hellene to distinguish the **name** *LORD* **Yah Veh** from the **title** *Lord* **Adonay**. In almost\* every instance where the **title** *Lord* **Adonay** is meant, *Lord* **Adonay** is preceded by the article **the**, or the possessive pronouns **me** or **my**. In almost\* every instance where the **name** *LORD* **Yah Veh** is meant, the article or pronouns are absent. Also, the context may indicate whether *Lord* **Adonay** or *LORD* **Yah Veh** is meant. You may confirm this by reading the margins of the Scofield Reference Edition of 1917.

\*We say **almost** because of variant manuscripts.

The Hebrew transliteration of the **name** of our *Lord* **Adonay** is **Yah Shua**.

The LEXICON defines **Yah Shua** as **Yah Saves**. With this research, we can now understand the full import of the following verse, which the *exeGeses* presents thus:

And she births a son; and calls his name Yah Shua, for he saves his people from their sins.

Matthew Matthaios 1:21

Transliteration is also of utmost importance in the name **Yah Hudah**, his people who are called by His name. Read Genesis 29:35, together with 2 Chronicles 7:14. Also see the SUMMARY of YAH HUDAH in the LEXICON.

### TRANSLATION and TRANSLITERATION of TITLES:

The *exegeses* distinguishes between the different Hebrew and Aramaic words usually translated **God** – **El**, **Elah**, **Elohim**; as well as the different words usually translated **Lord** — **adon**, **adoni**, **Adonay**.

The *exeGeses* transliterates accurately from the Hebrew the **title** of **Adonay Yah Shua Messiah**. All Messianists will find confirmation of their hope in this *exeGeses*.
