

**PSALMS 23—25**

**23** A Psalm of David.  
1 The LORD is my shepherd **Yah Veh Raah**;  
I shall not want **lack**.  
2 He maketh me to lie down **reposest me**  
in green pastures **sprouting folds**:  
he leadeth **guideth** me  
beside the *still waters* **waters of rest**.  
3 He restoreth my soul:  
he leadeth me in the paths of *righteousness* **justness**  
for his name's sake.  
4 Yea, though I walk through the valley  
of the shadow of death,  
I will fear **shall awe** no evil;  
for thou art with me;  
thy *rod* **scion** and thy *staff* **crutch**  
they *comfort* **sigh over** me.  
5 Thou *preparest* **arrangest** a table *before me* **at my face**  
in the presence of *mine enemies* **my tribulators**:  
thou anointest my head with *oil* **ointment**;  
my cup *runneth over* **satiatest**.  
6 Surely goodness and mercy shall *follow* **pursue** me  
all the days of my life:  
and I will  *dwell* **shall settle**  
in the house of the LORD **Yah Veh**  
for ever **a length of days**.

**24** A Psalm of David.  
1 The earth is the LORD'S **Yah Veh's**,  
and the fulness *thereof*;  
the world, and they that  *dwell* **settle** therein.  
2 For he hath founded it upon the seas,  
and established it upon the *floods* **rivers**.  
3 Who shall ascend  
into the *hill* **mountain of the LORD Yah Veh?**  
or who shall *stand* **rise** in his holy place?  
4 He that hath *clean hands* **innocent palms**,  
and a pure heart;  
who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity,  
nor *sworn* **oathed** deceitfully.  
5 He shall *receive* **lift** the blessing  
from the LORD **Yah Veh**,  
and *righteousness* **justness**  
from the God **Elohim** of his salvation.  
6 This is the generation of them that seek him,  
that seek thy face, O *Jacob* **Yaaqov**.  
Selah.  
7 Lift up your heads, O ye *gates* **portals**;  
and be ye lift up, ye  *everlasting doors* **eternal portals**;  
and the King **Sovereign** of glory **honour** shall *come in* **enter**.  
8 Who is this King **Sovereign** of glory **honour**?  
The LORD **Yah Veh** strong and mighty,  
the LORD **Yah Veh** mighty in  *battle war*.  
9 Lift up your heads, O ye *gates* **portals**;  
even lift them up, ye  *everlasting doors* **eternal portals**;  
and the King **Sovereign** of glory **honour** shall *come in* **enter**.  
10 Who is this King **Sovereign** of glory **honour**?  
The LORD of hosts **Yah Veh Sabaoth**,  
he is the King **Sovereign** of glory **honour**.

**25** A Psalm of David.  
1 Unto thee, O LORD **Yah Veh**, do I lift up my soul.  
2 O my God **Elohim**, I trust **confide** in thee:  
let me not be *ashamed* **shame**,  
let not mine enemies *triumph* **jump for joy** over me.  
3 Yea, let none that *wait on* **await** thee be *ashamed* **shame**:  
let them be *ashamed* **shame**  
which *transgress without cause* **deal vanity covertly**.  
4 Shew **Have** me **know** thy ways, O LORD **Yah Veh**;  
teach me thy paths.  
5 Lead **Aim** me in thy truth, and teach me:  
for thou art the God **Elohim** of my salvation;  
on thee do I *wait* **I await thee** all the day.  
6 Remember, O LORD **Yah Veh**,  
thy tender mercies  
and thy *loving kindnesses* **kind mercies**;  
for they *have been ever of old* **be eternal**.

**23** A Psalm by David.  
1 Yah Veh Raah;  
I lack not.

of the shadow of death,  
I awe no evil;  
for you are with me;  
your scion and your crutch sigh over me:  
5 you arrange a table at my face  
in the presence of my tribulators;  
you anoint my head with ointment;  
my cup satiates.  
6 Surely goodness and mercy pursue me  
all the days of my life;  
and I settle in the house of Yah Veh  
for a length of days.

**24** A Psalm by David.  
1 Unto Yah Veh is the earth and the fulness;  
the world and they who settle therein:  
2 for he founded it on the seas  
and established it on the rivers.  
3 Who ascends into the mountain of Yah Veh?  
Who rises in his holy place?  
4 He who has innocent palms and a pure heart;  
— who neither lifts his soul to vanity  
nor oaths deceitfully:  
5 he lifts a blessing from Yah Veh  
and justness from Elohim of his salvation.  
6 This is the generation of seekers  
who seek your face, O Yaaqov.  
Selah.  
7 Lift your heads, O you portals;  
be lifted, you eternal portals;  
and the Sovereign of honor enters.  
8 Who is this Sovereign of honor?  
Yah Veh strong and mighty!  
Yah Veh mighty in war!  
9 Lift your heads, O you portals;  
be lifted, you eternal portals;  
and the Sovereign of honor enters.  
10 Who is this Sovereign of honor?  
Yah Veh Sabaoth,  
he is the Sovereign of honor.  
Selah.

**25** By David.  
1 To you, O Yah Veh, I lift my soul;  
2 O my Elohim, I confide in you;  
may I neither shame  
nor my enemies jump for joy over me:  
3 yes, may none who await you shame;  
shame them who deal vanity covertly.  
4 Have me know your ways, O Yah Veh;  
teach me your paths:  
5 aim me in your truth and teach me;  
for you are Elohim of my salvation:  
I await you all the day.  
6 Remember, O Yah Veh,  
your tender mercies and your kind mercies;  
for they are eternal:
